November News

I wanted to say thanks to everyone for their patience and understanding as we repaired the church men's bathroom, which came right after we had remodeled it. The bathroom is finished now and looks good (and doesn't smell anymore, which is always a good thing!). My thanks, again, to Trustee John Schmedake, who was here for several full days helping me with the work, along with all the other work he does around the grounds.

Last month we had Pioneer Fire come in and do the annual fire alarm testing and fire extinguisher inspection. Everything is working well.

I am building a small (16' x 4') shed outside the Whitney building, which will be used to create space inside the Whitney building and metal storage container. We'll keep the yard tools and cones in the new space. I repurposed the eight 8' x 4' wooden stage pieces we had been storing, but don't need anymore because we have the new stage that PIE purchased earlier this year. I also used other scrap wood from other projects, so the only cost for the new shed space was about \$150 in metal roof materials.

Sometimes I feel like cleaning out and making space in the Whitney building is my never-ending task, like the guy in mythology that had to keep pushing a rock up a hill! But it is really starting to pay off. We need a good storage space because all our ministries have storage needs for a wide variety of things, so we are blessed to have that space. I think we are starting to get over the collective "hoarding" mentality we've had for so long, where we keep things that really don't need to be kept.

Besides the normal upkeep and maintenance, I'm going to be working to create a master map of the campus, which will show the location of all the utilities, fire alarms, AED's, 1st Aid stations, etc. I'm trying to create something that shows where everything is, which right now for the most part is just living in various people's memories. If you have some institutional knowledge about where utilities are or other things we need to have documented, please let me know. (I'm talking to you Alf Howald

We've been fortunate to have a few school parents volunteer around campus recently, and I'm very thankful for them. There is always work to do around the campus, so if you are interested in helping with any job, big or small, please let me know. Thanks!

Giving is a *Breeze*

The Church uses a software program that deals with social needs of the Church. This software is called Breeze. It allows for an easier way of getting information out to the Church members as a whole as well as small groups.

One aspect of this software is it has a modular that we can track church contribution.

To establish your on-line giving using the Breeze online giving program, follow the link:

Please be aware the Breeze on-line giving bank transfer feature does include a processing fee of 1%. The processing fee for credit cards is 2.9% plus a small transaction fee. Faith will absorb these fees but you have the option to give back both the transfer and credit card processing fees by simply checking the box. Upon doing so, the fees will be added to your donation.

Texting is a Breeze

With this software, we have an extended opportunity to communicate with you through text messaging. We are able to generate messages through the app directly to your phone. These messages are legitimate and not spam or fraudulent. Please make sure your information is up to date with the church office so you don't miss important notifications.



Text to Give

To donate by text, a donor simply:

- 1. Text the amount they'd like to give to (360) 732-8020 (e.g. \$50). Remember to include a space between your dollar amount and your keyword. If a user submits \$50Missions, they will receive a "Sorry, not sure what you meant" error message. The proper format must be \$50 Missions in order for the command to be received properly.
- 2. If a person has donated by text before, they'll receive a text in response confirming that their gift has been received successfully and they're done.
- 3. If it's the first time a person is donating by text, they'll be sent a message that says, "It looks like you are a new giver; to begin: (link provided). It will be a link to the church's online giving page. Clicking on the link they will be asked to supply their payment method (credit card, debit card, or bank account). This payment source will then be linked with their phone number so that, in the future, all they will need to do is text in the amount. (They will not need to re-enter their payment information.)
- 4. If the donor didn't specify a fund by keyword, donations will automatically go to the default fund in Breeze. **Example giving by keyword:** \$50 missions Note: Donors can only give to one fund at a time.
